General discussion followed. Tom Lehman said he had heard rumors that the City was to take bids for mowing in the future. He was interested as he will be there taking out tree stumps. He ask for authority to start removing these stumps at both cemeteries. Board approved. No motion necessary.

It was discussed if the City used the cemetery mowers, beside cemetery work, and they need repairs, shall that be charged to our budget?

Marcy said the city would cover that
expenses Chris Fangmeyer was not present.

May ignored the price to
mark graves at the time of burial.

It is to be part of purchaser price, no need
to add another charge.

Meeting was adjourned at 3:30 by a
motion by Jack, seconded by Heidi.
